Holy Day of Obligation

Thursday, February 9, 2012, Feast of Saint Maron, is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses will be at **9:00 A.M.** and at **6:30 P.M.** A Holy

Day of Obligation means that a Catholic person is obligated to attend Mass on that day under the penalty of mortal sin. **St. Maron is the Founder of the Maronite Church.**

Mystery of Penance

When coming to confess your sins, kneel and make the sign of the Cross, saying: In the Name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Then recite the general formula for confession, saying: Bless me, Father, for I have sinned. It has been _____ (weeks, months, years), since my last confession and these are my sins: (State your sins, and if possible, the number of times you have committed these sins since your last confession.) Then say: For these and for all of my sins, I am truly sorry.

The priest may ask you a few questions and give you some advice. Then he will ask you to do some act of penance, (which you should do after leaving the confessional). He will now give you "Absolution" to forgive you for all of your sins. At this time you pray the Act of Contrition, Saying:

O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended You, and I detest all my sins because of Your just punishments, but most of all because they offend You, my God, who art all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve with the help of Your grace to sin no more and to avoid the near occasion of sin. Amen.

When you are finished, leave the confessional and perform the act of penance that the priest has given you, and thank God for his mercy and love.
